Itinerary

Day 1 | Arrival in Johannesburg

On arrival at OR Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg you will be met and transferred privately to your hotel.

Check-in at the hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure. Your hotel has direct access into the Sandton City shopping mall, Johannesburg's premium shopping centre, also connected to Nelson Mandela Square which offers a variety of dining options.

- **Overnight - DAVINCI Hotel & Suites Nelson Mandela Square**

Day 2 | Johannesburg, Soweto & Apartheid Museum Full Day Tour (Breakfast)

This tour will begin by discovering Johannesburg's beauty and wealth by discovering its urban environment. You will then visit the inspiring Apartheid Museum dedicated to recounting the history of the rise and fall of Apartheid in 20th century South Africa. The exhibits are from film footage, photographs, text panels and artifacts illustrating the events and human stories of Apartheid. Thereafter you will get the opportunity to discover the former South-African president's house, in which you will hear about the Mandela family's history and times spent in Soweto.

- **Overnight - DAVINCI Hotel & Suites Nelson Mandela Square**

Day 3 | Johannesburg to Kruger (Full Board)

Transfer back to OR Tambo International Airport for your flight to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport. Here you will be met and transferred to and through Kruger National Park to your lodge located on a private concession within the National Park.

Enjoy lunch on arrival and check-in, before departing on your first afternoon game drive. As the very first private concession granted within Kruger National Park, Jock Safari Lodge is the original safari legend. Located in Kruger's southern region, where the Mitomeni and Biyamiti rivers meet to become one, it will feel like you're stepping back to South Africa's gold rush era. As you stare out at the untamed wild surrounding you, you'll envision Sir FitzPatrick and Jock's legendary quest across the wide-open African plains. This location and the history behind it are what make Jock Safari Lodge shine. We invite you to a Big 5 safari that's more authentic, immersive, and impactful than any other.

Day 4 | Full Day on Safari in Kruger National Park (Full Board)

When you come to Jock Safari Lodge, you're really coming to see the wild spaces and wildlife surrounding our lodge. If you're hungry for exploration, for deeply immersing yourself and learning about the bush's delicate balance and fascinating stories, this is the place for you.

Besides offering guests a space to relax and plenty of excitement, Jock Safari Lodge has a bigger conservation purpose you can learn about. From Big 5 game drives and wilderness walks to studying local fauna, flora and birdlife, there's much to marvel at that will move you.

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It's also perfect for that family holiday, with something for everyone. Little ones will love our Kids on Safari options, the nearby Leopard Creek invites you for a day of golf in the bush, and our Pilgrim's Rest Retreat offers an escape to enjoy pampering in the bush.

- **Overnight – Jock Safari Lodge**

Day 5 | Full Day on Safari in Kruger National Park (Full Board)

A typical day on safari starts with a pre-sunrise wake up for tea/coffee before heading off for the morning game drive at first light - this is the best time to spot wildlife when it's still cool and the animals are more active.

You will get back to the lodge in time for breakfast in the later part of the morning and after breakfast you will have time to rest, take a dip in the pool or maybe spoil yourself with a spa treatment. This is also the time the bush walks will take place. The diversity of fauna and flora in this unique concession truly comes alive when viewed on foot. Qualified walking guides provide the opportunity for guests to experience the excitement of approaching species on foot.

Next is lunch, followed by afternoon siesta time and time to enjoy the setting and facilities at the lodge. Afternoon tea is served before the afternoon game drive departs, usually around 4pm. Sundowners are enjoyed in the bush before returning to the lodge for dinner - the ranger will use a spotlight on the way back to look out for nocturnal creatures.

- **Overnight – Jock Safari Lodge**

Day 6 | Kruger National Park to Cape Town (Breakfast)

This morning after your last morning game drive and breakfast you will transfer back to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport for your flight to Cape Town.

On arrival you will be met by your guide and transferred to your hotel, which is conveniently located in the heart of the vibrant V&A Waterfront. This popular destination offers a wide variety of restaurants, bars, shops, markets, entertainment, activities and excursions, all within a safe walking distance from your hotel.

- **Overnight – Victoria & Alfred Hotel**

Day 7 | Robben Island Excursion (Breakfast)

Today starts with a Robben Island excursion. The tour takes 3.5 hours in total, including the ferry trips across the bay and back. Robben Island is most famous for being where former president Nelson Mandela spent 18 of his 27 years of imprisonment. It is also possible (at an additional cost) to do this tour on a private basis and also to have Nelson Mandela's former prison guard who later became a close friend, Christo Brand, be your guide on the island.

Robben Island, the unique symbol of "the triumph of the human spirit over adversity, suffering and injustice" with a rich 500 year old multi-layered history, is visited every year by thousands of people eager to understand and honour the important aspects of South Africa's history that the Island represents.

On return to the V&A Waterfront it will be lunch time and you will have the remainder of the day at your own leisure.

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- **Overnight – Victoria & Alfred Hotel**

Day 8 | Private morning Cape Town City Tour with Table Mountain, Lunch in Langa with Township Tour (Breakfast)

You will be met by your guide in your hotel reception area and taken on a Half Day Cape Town City Orientation Tour to learn about Cape Town's rich history and vibrant cultures. The day starts with a cableway trip to the top of one of the World's Natural Wonders – Table Mountain, also the city's most iconic and recognisable landmark. Explore the walking trails at the top and take in the many different views point across the City Bowl, Table Bay, Atlantic Seaboard and Peninsula.

From Table Mountain your guide will take you back down into the city to visit the colourful Bo Kaap (Cape Malay Quarter), enjoy a walk through the Company Gardens and Greenmarket Square and an orientation drive taking in some of the important historical buildings (for example the Castle of Good Hope – South Africa's oldest building), streets and features.

Highlights:

- Table Mountain and the aerial cableway (weather depending)
- Bo-Kaap – one of the city's most Instagrammable spots thanks to its picturesque colourful houses and cobblestone streets
- The Company Gardens – a large public park lined with oak trees and surrounded by iconic historical buildings, museums and art galleries
- Vibrant Greenmarket Square market offering a wide range of African arts and crafts
- Orientation drive to see The Castle of Good Hope, City Hall, Grand Parade and Adderley Street with its many statues and historical buildings
- **Overnight – Victoria & Alfred Hotel**

Day 9 | Private Full Day Cape Peninsula Tour (Breakfast)

You will be met by your guide in your hotel reception area and taken on a Full Day Cape Peninsula Tour. Cape Town is frequently acknowledged and awarded as being one of the world's most beautiful places – this tour will show you why! Experience the spectacular natural splendour and abundance of life of the Cape Peninsula. With scenic views to take your breath away and photo opportunities galore this trip also takes you through a World Heritage Site – the Cape Floral Kingdom.

Travel along the Atlantic Seaboard to Hout Bay, passing magnificent beaches and the coastal suburbs of Clifton, Camps Bay and Llandudno. From the busy fishing harbour at Hout Bay you have the option of a boat trip to see the thousands of Cape Fur Seals living on a rocky outcrop. Browse for souvenirs at the Hout Bay Craft Market or take a walk on the beach and paddle your feet in the sea.

The tour continues over Chapman's Peak, known as one of the most spectacular scenic drives in the world, all the way along the Peninsula to the southern tip at Cape Point. An invigorating walk takes you to the two lighthouses at the top and bottom of the headland, from where you will enjoy extraordinary views of the cliffs and the ocean below. Alternatively, you could take an optional short funicular ride to the top. Take a photo down at the most south-western point of the African continent at the Cape of Good Hope beach.

Lunch will be enjoyed at a seaside restaurant (excluded and for your own account) before we make our way along the False Bay coastline to the Naval village of Simon's Town. We will

visit the delightful African Penguins of Boulders Beach and then the drive takes us back via Cape Town's coastal and southern suburbs.

Highlights:

- Drive along the Atlantic Sea Board passing the beautiful beaches of Clifton and Camps Bay
- Photo stop at Maidens Cove to take in the views of the Twelve Apostles Mountain range, Camps Bay Beach and Lions Head
- Stop at Hout Bay Harbour – a busy fishing harbour
- Optional boat ride to Duiker Island to see the Cape Fur Seals
- Chapman's Peak Drive – known as one of the World's most beautiful drives
- Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve and Cape Point – most South-Western point of Africa and the southern tip of the Cape Peninsula, spectacular scenery
- False Bay Coastal Road – look out for whales between June and November
- Visit the comical African Penguins at Boulders Beach
- Simon's Town – home to South Africa's Naval Base
- Picturesque drive past Kalk Bay and Muizenberg – see the famous colourful beach huts
- Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens – optional and time dependent

Day 10 | Private Full Day Cape Winelands Tour (Breakfast)

You will be met by your guide in your hotel reception area and taken on a Full Day Cape Winelands Tour. Situated only 45 minutes away from Cape Town, the Cape Winelands are surrounded by majestic mountains, beautiful vineyards and typical Cape Dutch style architecture. The Cape Winelands include the towns of Stellenbosch, Franschhoek and Paarl and are home to more than 200 wine estates and wine farms producing top-quality world-class wines. This region is also highly acclaimed for its many award-winning restaurants.

Head off to the heart of South Africa's wine industry, Stellenbosch, boasting great beauty and culture that is steeped in South African history. Walk down the canal-lined avenues, in the shade of giant oak trees and beautifully preserved historical buildings. With the sheer vastness of wine estates on offer, we are truly spoilt for choice. Enjoy wine tastings at 3 different estates in Paarl, Stellenbosch and Franschhoek, with a lunch stop in between.

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- Visit Oom Samie se Winkel an interesting and old-fashioned general dealer
