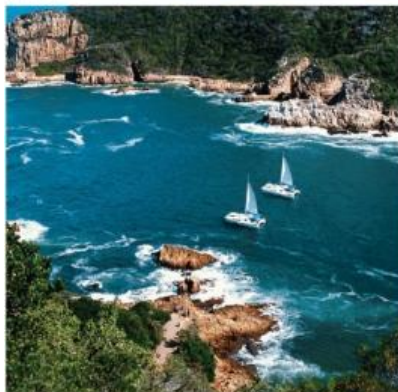

Itinerary:

Day 1 | Arrival in Cape Town

Upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport you will be met and transferred to your hotel where you will spend the rest of the day and evening at your own leisure.

- **Overnight at the Garden Court Victoria Junction (standard room) or similar**

Day 2 | Half Day Cape Town City Tour & Table Mountain

You will be met by your guide in your hotel reception area and taken on a Half Day Cape Town City Orientation Tour to learn about Cape Town's rich history and vibrant cultures. The day starts with a cableway trip to the top of one of the World's Natural Wonders – Table Mountain, also the city's most iconic and recognisable landmark. Explore the walking trails at the top and take in the many different views point across the City Bowl, Table Bay, Atlantic Seaboard and Peninsula.

From Table Mountain your guide will take you back down into the city to visit the colourful Bo Kaap (Cape Malay Quarter), enjoy a walk through the Company Gardens and Greenmarket Square and an orientation drive taking in some of the important historical buildings (for example the Castle of Good Hope – South Africa's oldest building), streets and features.

Highlights:

- Table Mountain and the aerial cableway (weather depending, cableway tickets for own account)
- Bo-Kaap – one of the city's most Instagrammable spots thanks to its picturesque colourful houses and cobblestone streets
- The Company Gardens – a large public park lined with oak trees and surrounded by iconic historical buildings, museums and art galleries
- Orientation drive to see The Castle of Good Hope, City Hall, Grand Parade and Adderley Street with its many statues and historical buildings

The rest of the day will be at your own leisure, you can choose from a wide range of optional activities and excursions that Cape Town has to offer.

- **Overnight at the Garden Court Victoria Junction (standard room) or similar**

Day 3 | Full day Cape Peninsula Tour

You will be met by your guide in your hotel reception area and taken on a Full Day Cape Peninsula Tour. Cape Town is frequently acknowledged and awarded as being one of the world's most beautiful places – this tour will show you why! Experience the spectacular natural splendour and abundance of life of the Cape Peninsula. With scenic views to take your breath away and photo opportunities galore this trip also takes you through a World Heritage Site – the Cape Floral Kingdom.

Highlights:

- Drive along the Atlantic Sea Board passing the beautiful beaches of Clifton and Camps Bay
 - Photo stop at Maidens Cove to take in the views of the Twelve Apostles mountain range, Camps Bay Beach and Lions Head
 - Stop at Hout Bay Harbour – a busy fishing harbour
 - Optional boat ride to Duiker Island to see the Cape Fur Seals
 - Chapman's Peak Drive – known as one of the World's most beautiful drives
 - Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve and Cape Point – most South-Western point of Africa and the southern tip of the Cape Peninsula, spectacular scenery
 - False Bay Coastal Road – look out for whales between June and November
 - Visit the comical African Penguins at Boulders Beach
 - Simon's Town – home to South Africa's Naval Base
 - Picturesque drive past Kalk Bay and Muizenberg – see the famous colourful beach huts
- **Overnight at the Garden Court Victoria Junction (standard room) or similar**

Day 4 | Optional Full Day Cape Winelands Tour

09.00 You will be met by your guide in your hotel reception area and taken on a Full Day Cape Winelands Tour. Situated only 45 minutes away from Cape Town, the Cape Winelands are surrounded by majestic mountains, beautiful vineyards and typical Cape Dutch style architecture. The Cape Winelands include the towns of Stellenbosch, Franschhoek and Paarl and are home to more than 150 wine estates and wine farms producing top-quality world-class wines. This region is also highly acclaimed for its many award-winning restaurants.

Highlights:

- 3 Wine Tastings, with a chocolate OR cheese and wine pairing included, at various wine estates
- **Overnight at the Garden Court Victoria Junction (standard room) or similar**

Day 5 | Cape Town to Oudtshoorn via Route 62

420km Approximate driving time 5 hours (7 hours with stops)

This morning your driver-guide will meet you at your hotel reception (please ensure your bags are packed and you have checked out of the hotel) at 09.00 to depart on the next leg of your South African adventure – exploring the beautiful Garden Route.

Travel along the famous Route 62 from the Cape Winelands en route to Oudtshoorn. This route has previously been named "World's Best Road Trip Destination" by CNN! There are lots of interesting stops and places to discover along the way and it is also known to be "The World's Longest Wine Route". A good place to stop about halfway through the journey is Barrydale, where there are a few options for lunch (for your own account).

Check-in at your accommodation and enjoy the peaceful and picturesque setting on a working ostrich farm. Dinner (for your own account) can either be enjoyed at your accommodation or at a restaurant in the town.

- **Overnight at La Plume Boutique Hotel & Spa (standard room) or similar**

Day 6 | Full day Oudtshoorn Tour, Transfer to Knysna

You will be met by your guide in your hotel reception area at 09.00 sharp and taken on a full day trip in Oudtshoorn. After the tour you will travel to Knysna which lies 120km (2-hours drive) from Oudtshoorn, traveling over the spectacular Outeniqua Pass and onto the Garden Route.

Your first stop will be at the Cango Caves, which are situated 30km / 30-minutes' drive outside of Oudtshoorn. Here you will join the Heritage Tour at 11.00 - an easy walk through the first six largest and most spectacular halls and continuing through to the "African Drum room". This tour commences with information on the real discoverers and inhabitants of the cave and then winds its way through the rest of the Caves' cultural and historical heritage. A comfortable walk through the most majestic of the cave chambers. Experienced and knowledgeable guides will accompany you on this journey of discovery and knowledge which takes around 1-hour to complete.

Your next stop for the day is Safari Ostrich Farm for a guided tractor tour where you will get to meet and learn more about these large flightless birds that have had such a big impact on the economy of the town. This tour also takes 1-hour, after which you can shop for some ostrich leather products in the shop.

You will then travel to Knysna, arriving at your hotel in the late afternoon.

- **Overnight at Premier Hotel Knysna The Moorings (standard room) or similar**

Day 7 | Visit to Monkeyland and Plettenberg Bay, at leisure / optional activities

Today you will visit the neighbouring town of Plettenberg Bay and enjoy a tour of Monkeyland. The afternoon you will be at your own leisure and there are optional activities you might choose to join.

Optional Activities in the Knysna Area:

- Kayak or SUP (stand up paddle) on the Lagoon
- Whale Watching boat excursion
- Sunset Cruise or Sunset Sail
- Champagne & Oysters Cruise
- Lagoon Cruise

Day 8 | Knysna to Bellevue Forest Reserve via Tsitsikamma

After breakfast at your hotel you will travel into the Eastern Cape Province to your safari destination. En-route visit the Storms River Mouth, part of Tsitsikamma for a walk through the forest.

Check-in at your luxury tent at Bellevue and enjoy your first afternoon game drive. Dinner will be back at the camp.

This morning join a giraffe tracking safari on foot in the 2500-hectare private game reserve. In the afternoon enjoy another safari game drive on the reserve.
